#### **1.** Software Requirements

The following are software requirements that allow for full functionality of the bLoyal integration with NCR Counterpoint:

- SQL Server 2008 R2.
- .NET Framework 4.7.2 or greater

#### 2. Prerequisites

- 1. Log in to Counterpoint with Admin-level credentials.
- 2. Create a new item called **Price-1** as a **non-inventory item** set to **\$0** price. This will be used as the *0 Quantity Product Code*, a placeholder used to launch some of the bLoyal POS Snippets without affecting your transactions. Our stored procedures installed with our connectors will handle removing this placeholder product from your transactions automatically.
- 3. As detailed in Section 4, it will be necessary to create some new button pages which will act as batch actions for each new bLoyal button.
- 4. Ensure all cashiers have the **Hold and recall** permission enabled. This Counterpoint function is critical for the bLoyal integration's full operability.
- 5. The bLoyal connectors for Counterpoint will need to be granted local read/write access to the following directories (and their subdirectories):
  - C:\ProgramData\bLoyal
  - C:\Program Files (x86)\bLoyal

#### 3. Install bLoyal POS Connector for Counterpoint

- While logged into a Windows Administrator account on your Counterpoint POS register system, run the **bLoyal POS Connector for Counterpoint** installer provided by the bLoyal team. You may always find the latest version <u>here</u>.
- 2. Select install option for **All Users**, if prompted.
- 3. Click on the **Finish** button to complete the setup.

#### 4. Create bLoyal Buttons in Counterpoint POS

#### 4.1 bLoyal Master Settings

Required to access bLoyal POS Connector settings and toggle bLoyal functionality.

- 1. Log into Counterpoint with Admin user credentials.
- 2. Go to Home => Setup => Point of Sale => Touchscreen Codes.
- 3. Select the *Touchscreen Code* set you wish to add the bLoyal custom buttons to or create a new *Touchscreen Code* set to add custom buttons for bLoyal functionality. (See Figure 1.1). Note: We recommend making a copy of your existing *Touchscreen Code* set and calling the new copy, **BLOYAL**. This way, you can roll out bLoyal to specific registers by setting up and then assigning the new *BLOYAL Touchscreen Code* to registers of your choice. Ordinarily, this would just be one register initially.
- 4. After you select/create the Touchscreen Code, click **Button Editor** (circled in Figure 1.1).
- 5. Clicking **Button Editor** will navigate you to the menu shown in Figure 1.2.


- 6. Once you are on the page shown in Figure 1.2, you may set up a page for the **bLoyal Master Settings.** 
  - a. Click **New Page** (highlighted in Figure 1.2). Type *bLoyal Master Settings* in the pop-up window to name the page and then click **OK**.
  - b. You will be brought to the new page you just created. Select the first button to the right (as pointed out in Figure 1.3) and then type in the **Caption** of the button as *bLoyal Master Settings*.
  - c. **Action** = *External*
  - d. **Page Action** = None
  - e. **Command** = C:\Program Files (x86)\bLoyal\POS Connector for Counterpoint\bLoyal Loyalty\bLoyal.Loyalty.exe
  - f. **Argument** = *configuration*
  - g. Now, select your default/home/main menu page from the **Page** menu.
  - h. Click on a blank button that you would like to assign as the **bLoyal Master Settings** button.
    - You may need to increase the number of button columns/rows first on the **General** tab of the Button Editor if no blank buttons are available. You will need to allow room for ~7-10 new buttons, depending on your bLoyal Edition. For example, the *Create Order* & *Check Inventory* buttons will not be needed if the company will not be using bLoyal order processing.
  - i. Type in the **Caption**: *bLoyal Master Settings*
  - j. **Image** may be set to the bLoyal icon found in:
  - *C*:\*Program Files (x86)*\*bLoyal*\*POS Connector for Counterpoint*\*bLoyal Loyalty* k. Set the button's **Action** as *Run page*, then in the **Run page** dropdown menu
  - below, select the *bLoyal Master Settings* page that you created prior.
  - I. Click the **Close** button.
  - m. **Save** the settings on the Touchscreen Code window (floppy disk icon).



#### 4.2 Hold and Recall Button

This button is necessary for bLoyal functionality and must have a function key bound to it. You may optionally clear its caption and set the font color to match the button box so that it appears as a blank button to staff. If you already have a **Hold** <u>and</u> **recall** button (not to be confused with **Hold recall** which is a totally different function), you may instead simply add a function key to it (ex., the F12 key) in Counterpoint if one isn't already set. Your chosen function key will also need to be entered into the bLoyal Master Settings as detailed in Section 5.

- 1. Go to Home => Setup => Point of Sale => Touchscreen Codes.
- 2. Select the *Touchscreen Code* set you had previously chosen to add bLoyal buttons to (See Figure 1.1), then click **Button Editor** (circled in Figure 1.1).
- 3. Click on your existing *Hold and recall* button or an empty button slot to the right of your existing header buttons.
  - a. You may need to first increase the number of *Top* buttons on the **General** tab of the Button Editor if none are available. You will need to allow room for 1-2 new buttons up top potentially (depending on whether you already have *Hold and recall* and/or *Void current ticket* buttons set up already).
- 4. Confirm **Action** is set to *Hold and recall*.
- 5. Click **ShortCut** and then press the function key (ex., the F12 key) you want to associate it with.
- 6. Click on the **Close** button and then **Save** the changes (floppy disk icon).

#### 4.3 Void Current Ticket

This must be set up for bLoyal functionality. If you already have a standard **Void current ticket** button, you will need to modify it to add in the necessary bLoyal function that must take place prior to the void (via a button page as explained below). If creating a new button, you may optionally clear its caption/match colors so that it appears as a blank button to staff.

- 1. Go to **Home => Setup => Point of Sale => Touchscreen Codes**.
- 2. Select the *Touchscreen Code* set you had previously chosen to add bLoyal buttons to (See Figure 1.1), then click **Button Editor** (circled in Figure 1.1).
- 3. Click **New Page** and entitle it: *bLoyal Void Current Ticket*
- 4. You will be presented with a new page of touchscreen buttons (on the right side of the screen).

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Button: *bLoyal Void Current Ticket* Function

- 1. Select 1<sup>st</sup> button at the right side of the screen (top-leftmost button).
- 2. **Action** = *External*
- 3. **Image** may optionally be set to the bLoyal icon found in: *C:\Program Files (x86)\bLoyal\POS Connector for Counterpoint\bLoyal Loyalty*
- 4. **Caption** = *bLoyal Void Current Ticket*
- 5. **Command** = C:\Program Files (x86)\bLoyal\POS Connector for Counterpoint\bLoyal Loyalty\bLoyal.Loyalty.exe
- 6. **Argument** = *voidcurrentticket*

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Button: Void Current Ticket Function

- 1. Select 2<sup>nd</sup> button.
- 2. **Action** = *Void current ticket*

#### Void Current Ticket Button


- 1. Now, select your default/home/main menu page from the **Page** menu.
- 2. Select your existing **Void Current Ticket** button.
- 3. **Caption** = *Void Current Ticket*
- 4. **Action** = *Run page*
- 5. **Run page** = *bLoyal Void Current Ticket*
- 6. **Image** may be set to the bLoyal icon found in:
- C:\Program Files (x86)\bLoyal\POS Connector for Counterpoint\bLoyal Loyalty
- 7. Click the **Close** button.
- 8. Save the settings on the Touchscreen Code window (floppy disk icon).





#### 4.4 bLoyal Pay Button

*It is necessary to add the bLoyal Pre-Tender hook prior to launching the standard Pay Codes page.* 



- 1. Go to Home => Setup => Point of Sale => Touchscreen Codes.
- 2. Select the *Touchscreen Code* set you had previously chosen to add bLoyal buttons to (See Figure 1.1), then click **Button Editor** (circled in Figure 1.1).
- 3. Click **New Page** and entitle it: *bLoyal Pay*
- 4. You will be presented with a new page of touchscreen buttons (on the right side of the screen).

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Button: Hold and Recall Function

- 1. Select 1<sup>st</sup> button at the right side of the screen (top-leftmost button).
- 2. Action = Hold and recall

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Button: bLoyal Pre-Tender Function

- 1. Select 2<sup>nd</sup> button.
- 2. Action = External
- 3. **Image** may be set to the bLoyal icon found in: *C:\Program Files (x86)\bLoyal\POS Connector for Counterpoint\bLoyal Loyalty*
- 4. **Caption** = *bLoyal Pre-Tender*
- 5. **Command** = C:\Program Files (x86)\bLoyal\POS Connector for Counterpoint\bLoyal Loyalty\bLoyal.Loyalty.exe
- 6. **Argument** = *pretender*

#### 3<sup>rd</sup> Button: Pay Codes

- 1. Select 3<sup>rd</sup> Button.
- 2. Action = Run Page
- 3. **Run Page** = *Pay Codes* (or your custom payment tender button page).
- 4. Click **Close** button.
- 5. Save the settings on the Touchscreen Code window (floppy disk icon).

#### Modified Pay Button

- 1. Now, edit your default/home/main menu page from the **Page** menu.
- 2. Select your existing *Pay* button or create one if not present.
- 3. **Action** = *Run page*
- 4. **Run page** = *bLoyal Pay*
- 5. Click **Close** button.
- 6. **Save** the settings on the Touchscreen Code window (floppy disk icon).



#### 4.5 Find Customer Button

This required button allows customer search, selection, and creation. Also displays some high-level customer info.

#### Create New Page

- 1. Go to Home => Setup => Point of Sale => Touchscreen Codes.
- 2. Select the *Touchscreen Code* set you had previously chosen to add bLoyal buttons to (See Figure 1.1), then click **Button Editor** (circled in Figure 1.1).
- 3. Click **New Page** and entitle it: *bLoyal Find Customer*
- 4. You will be presented with a new page of touchscreen buttons (on the right side of the screen).

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Button: Add Item Function

- 1. Select 1<sup>st</sup> button at the right side of the screen (top-leftmost button).
- 2. Action = Item
- 3. Select *Price-1* in the **Item** field (used as the bLoyal 0 Quantity placeholder item).
- 4. Set *Default qty* = 0.

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Button: Hold and Recall Function

- 1. Select 2<sup>nd</sup> button.
- 2. **Action** = Hold and recall

#### 3<sup>rd</sup> Button: bLoyal *Find Customer* Function

- 1. Select 3<sup>rd</sup> button.
- 2. Action = External
- 3. **Image** may be set to the bLoyal icon found in: *C:\Program Files (x86)\bLoyal\POS Connector for Counterpoint\bLoyal Loyalty*
- 4. **Caption** = *bLoyal Find Customer*
- 5. **Command** = C:\Program Files (x86)\bLoyal\POS Connector for Counterpoint\bLoyal Loyalty\bLoyal.Loyalty.exe
- 6. **Argument** = *findcustomer*
- 7. Click **Close** button.
- 8. **Save** the settings on the Touchscreen Code window (floppy disk icon).

#### **bLoyal Find Customer Button**

- 1. Now, select your default/home/main menu page from the **Page** menu.
- 2. Select a blank button that you would like to set up as your **bLoyal Find Customer** button.
- 3. **Caption** = *bLoyal Find Customer*
- 4. **Action** = *Run page*
- 5. **Run page** = *bLoyal Find Customer*
- 6. **Image** may be set to the bLoyal icon found in: C:\Program Files (x86)\bLoyal\POS Connector for Counterpoint\bLoyal Loyalty
- 7. Click the **Close** button.
- 8. **Save** the settings on the Touchscreen Code window (floppy disk icon).



#### 4.6 View Customer Button

View/edit all customer information with this required button.

#### Create New Page

- 1. Go to Home => Setup => Point of Sale => Touchscreen Codes.
- 2. Select the *Touchscreen Code* set you had previously chosen to add bLoyal buttons to (See Figure 1.1), then click **Button Editor** (circled in Figure 1.1).
- 3. Click New Page and entitle it: bLoyal View Customer
- 4. You will be presented with a new page of touchscreen buttons (on the right side of the screen).

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Button: Hold and Recall Function

- 1. Select 1<sup>st</sup> button at the right side of the screen (top-leftmost button).
- 2. Action = Hold and recall

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Button: bLoyal View Customer Function

- 1. Select 2<sup>nd</sup> button.
- 2. Action = External

- 4. Action = Run page
- 5. **Run page** = *bLoyal View Customer*
- 6. **Image** may be set to the bLoyal icon found in: C:\Program Files (x86)\bLoyal\POS Connector for Counterpoint\bLoyal Loyalty
- 7. Click the **Close** button.
- 8. **Save** the settings on the Touchscreen Code window (floppy disk icon).



#### 4.7 Quick Signup Button

This button will make it very easy and quick to sign up new customers using a preconfigured signup form with required and optional customer fields of your choosing. These are configured in bLoyal Director under **Channels => POS Snippet Profiles**.

#### Create New Page

- 1. Go to Home => Setup => Point of Sale => Touchscreen Codes.
- 2. Select the *Touchscreen Code* set you had previously chosen to add bLoyal buttons to (See Figure 1.1), then click **Button Editor** (circled in Figure 1.1).
- 3. Click **New Page** and entitle it: *bLoyal Quick Signup*
- 4. You will be presented with a new page of touchscreen buttons (on the right side of the screen).

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Button: Add Item Function

- 1. Select 1<sup>st</sup> button at the right side of the screen (top-leftmost button).
- 2. Action = Item
- 3. Select *Price-1* in the **Item** field (used as the bLoyal 0 Quantity placeholder item).

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Button: Hold and Recall Function

- 6. **Image** may be set to the bLoyal icon found in: C:\Program Files (x86)\bLoyal\POS Connector for Counterpoint\bLoyal Loyalty
- 7. Click the **Close** button.
- 8. **Save** the settings on the Touchscreen Code window (floppy disk icon).



#### 4.8 Quick Edit Button

*This button will make it very easy and quick to edit existing customer info using the same Quick Signup form utilized for new customers.* 

#### Create New Page

- 1. Go to Home => Setup => Point of Sale => Touchscreen Codes.
- 2. Select the *Touchscreen Code* set you had previously chosen to add bLoyal buttons to (See Figure 1.1), then click **Button Editor** (circled in Figure 1.1).
- 3. Click **New Page** and entitle it: *bLoyal Quick Edit*
- 4. You will be presented with a new page of touchscreen buttons (on the right side of the screen).

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Button: Hold and Recall Function

- 1. Select 1<sup>st</sup> button at the right side of the screen (top-leftmost button).
- 2. **Action** = Hold and recall

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Button: bLoyal Quick Edit Function

#### 4.9 Apply Coupon Button

Use to view and apply coupons powered by bLoyal.

- 1. Go to Home => Setup => Point of Sale => Touchscreen Codes.
- 2. Select the *Touchscreen Code* set you had previously chosen to add bLoyal buttons to (See Figure 1.1), then click **Button Editor** (circled in Figure 1.1).
- 3. Click **New Page** and entitle it: *bLoyal Apply Coupon*
- 4. You will be presented with a new page of touchscreen buttons (on the right side of the screen).

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Button: *Hold and Recall* Function

- 1. Select 1<sup>st</sup> button at the right side of the screen (top-leftmost button).
- 2. **Action** = Hold and recall

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Button: *bLoyal Apply Coupon* Function

- 6. **Image** may be set to the bLoyal icon found in:
  - C:\Program Files (x86)\bLoyal\POS Connector for Counterpoint\bLoyal Loyalty
- 7. Click the **Close** button.
- 8. Save the settings on the Touchscreen Code window (floppy disk icon).



#### 4.10 Gift Card Button

Use to redeem gift cards powered by bLoyal. You may also check gift card balances.

#### **Create New Page**

- 1. Go to Home => Setup => Point of Sale => Touchscreen Codes.
- 2. Select the *Touchscreen Code* set you had previously chosen to add bLoyal buttons to (See Figure 1.1), then click **Button Editor** (circled in Figure 1.1).
- 3. Click **New Page** and entitle it: *bLoyal Gift Card*
- 4. You will be presented with a new page of touchscreen buttons (on the right side of the screen).

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Button: *Hold and Recall* Function

- 1. Select 1<sup>st</sup> button at the right side of the screen (top-leftmost button).
- 2. **Action** = Hold and recall

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Button: *bLoyal Gift Card* Function

- 1. Select 2<sup>nd</sup> button.
- 2. Action = External
- 3. **Image** may be set to the bLoyal icon found in: *C:\Program Files (x86)\bLoyal\POS Connector for Counterpoint\bLoyal Loyalty*
